



## DRESS CODE 2011-2012

A higher standard of dress encourages greater respect for individual students and results in a higher standard of behavior. Our dress code indicates appropriate school dress for normal school days. Renaissance Elementary & Middle Charter School reserves the right to make dress code changes during the school year as necessary. All uniforms are subject to approval from the school administration. Every student in attendance is required to wear a school uniform and to follow these dress code guidelines.

### Boys—Grades K-5

- Khaki or navy pants/shorts with school initials (RECS)
- Red, white or blue polo type shirt with school emblem
- Red Friday/Field Trip T-Shirt

### Girls—Grades K-5

- Khaki or navy pants/shorts/skorts with school initials (RECS)
- Red and blue plaid skorts with school initials (RECS)
- Red, white or blue polo style shirt with school emblem
- Red Friday/Field Trip T-Shirt

### PE—Grades K-5 Navy PE shorts with school initials (RECS)

- White PE T-Shirt with RECS Emblems

### All Students

- Solid black or brown leather style belts are required.
- Two bottom buttons on polo shirts must be buttoned.
- If an undershirt is worn, it must be a short sleeve solid white t-shirt.
- Solid black, navy or white colored sneakers or closed-toe shoes (such as loafers)—No patterns on sneakers or slip-on sneakers. Shoes must be worn with Velcro closed or laces tied at all times.
- Only white, ankle-length socks may be worn. Socks must be worn above the shoe.
- Hair Styles:  
Boys (Grades K-5): Hair must be kept neatly and evenly in a simple style. It must be worn short enough in the back so that it does not touch the top of the shirt collar. Hair must not hang in the face and cannot obstruct the eyes. Pony tails are not permitted. No fad-type styles, such as mushrooms, tails, multi-layered cuts, spikes, carving marks, shaved or close crew cut (no shorter than #2—scalp is not to be visible), or unnatural colors. In addition, Middle School boys must be clean-shaven at all times.  
Girls (Grades K-5): Hairstyles must be simple and neat. Hair must not hang in the face and cannot obstruct the eyes. Unusual cuts, extreme or fad-type styles are not permitted. Coloring the hair is not appropriate at this age and unnatural hair colors (pink, red, blue, purple, green, etc.) are not permitted.
- No bandanas, hats or headbands are permitted.
- Jewelry is limited to stud-style earrings, watches and one thin chain tucked in the uniform shirt. Rings and bracelets are not permitted.
- Only approved outer wear with the school logo may be worn.

All uniforms must be purchased through the uniform vendor and embroidered with the proper logos. Uniforms that are altered for length (other than pant legs), belt loops, etc., will be considered a uniform violation. All Students—Grades 6:

- MONDAY-THURSDAY

  2. Navy or Khaki Pants with Logo
- FRIDAY – ALL STUDENTS
  1. White Oxford Shirt and Tie with Logo
  2. Navy or Khaki Pants with Logo

All Students—Grades 7:

- MONDAY-THURSDAY
  1. **Navy** Polo Shirt with Logo
  2. Navy or Khaki Pants with Logo
- FRIDAY – ALL STUDENTS
  3. White Oxford Shirt and Tie with Logo
  4. Navy or Khaki Pants with Logo

All Students—Grades 8:

- MONDAY-THURSDAY
  1. **Royal Blue** Polo Shirt with Logo
  2. Navy or Khaki Pants with Logo
- FRIDAY – ALL STUDENTS
  5. White Oxford Shirt and Tie with Logo
  6. Navy or Khaki Pants with Logo

PE—Grades 6-8 (ONLY FOR STUDENTS TAKING PE ELECTIVE)

- Navy PE shorts with school initials (RMCS)
- Light Blue PE T-Shirt with RMCS Emblem

All Students

- Winter Wear: Jackets with hoodies will **not** be permitted. Only approved sweaters with logo will be permitted.
- Solid black or brown leather style belts are required.
- Two bottom buttons on polo shirts must be buttoned.
- If an undershirt is worn, it must be a short sleeve solid white t-shirt.
- Solid black, navy or white colored sneakers or closed-toe shoes (such as loafers)—No patterns on sneakers or slip-on sneakers. Shoes must be worn with Velcro closed or laces tied at all times.
- Only white, ankle-length socks may be worn. Socks must be worn above the shoe.
- Hair Styles:
  - Boys (Grades 6-8): Hair must be kept neatly and evenly in a simple style. It must be worn short enough in the back so that it does not touch the top of the shirt collar. Hair must not hang in the face and cannot obstruct the eyes. Pony tails are not permitted. No fad-type styles, such as mushrooms, tails, multi-layered cuts, mohawks, spikes, carving marks, shaved or close crew cut (no shorter than #2—scalp is not to be visible), or unnatural colors. In addition, Middle School boys must be clean-shaven at all times.
  - Girls (Grades 6-8): Hairstyles must be simple and neat. Hair must not hang in the face and cannot obstruct the eyes. Unusual cuts, extreme or fad-type styles are not permitted. Coloring the hair is not appropriate at this age and unnatural hair colors (pink, red, blue, purple, green, etc.) are not permitted.
- No bandanas, hats or headbands are permitted.
- Jewelry is limited to stud-style earrings, watches and one thin chain tucked in the uniform shirt. Rings and bracelets are not permitted.
- Only approved outer wear with the school logo may be worn.

All uniforms must be purchased through the uniform vendor and embroidered with the proper logos.
